Mahadji Shinde Chhatri – An 18th-century memorial dedicated to the Maratha commander Mahadji Shinde, renowned for its exquisite Rajput and Maratha architecture.



Shaniwar Wada Fort – The historic seat of the Peshwas, built in 1732, and one of Pune's most iconic landmarks reflecting Maratha heritage.



Shreemant Dagdusheth Halwai Ganpati Temple – A revered Lord Ganesha temple famous for its magnificent idol, rich traditions, and grand Ganesh festival celebrations.



Darshan Museum – An immersive multimedia museum showcasing the inspiring life and teachings of Sadhu Vaswani through advanced audio-visual exhibits.



National Defence Academy (NDA), Khadakwasla – India's premier tri-services military academy where cadets of the Army, Navy, and Air Force train together.



Aga Khan Palace – A national monument built in 1892, closely associated with Mahatma Gandhi and India's freedom movement.



Khadakwasla Dam – A picturesque reservoir on the Mutha River, popular for its scenic views, pleasant evenings, and nearby local food stalls.



Parvati Hill Temple – One of Pune's oldest heritage sites, offering panoramic city views along with ancient temples atop the hill.



Chaturshringi Temple – A centuries-old temple dedicated to Goddess Chaturshringi, attracting thousands of devotees, especially during Navratri.



Pataleshwar Cave Temple – An 8th-century rock-cut Shiva temple carved from a single basalt rock, showcasing remarkable ancient craftsmanship.



BAPS Swaminarayan Temple – A beautifully carved Hindu temple known for its peaceful atmosphere, intricate architecture, and spiritual significance.
